## **Public Health Emergency**

The COVID-19 Public Health Emergency (PHE) will end on May 11, 2023.

As a result of this announcement, plan sponsors will no longer be required to pay for the COVID-19 over-the-counter (OTC) test kits after May 11. Solicitor Michael Balducci and Jon Sapochak reviewed the options and their recommendation was for CS Trust plans NOT to continue the coverage effective May 12, 2023.

The CS Trust officers reviewed and approved the recommendation to cancel coverage for the COVID-19 OTC test kits effective May 12, 2023.

Both Geisinger and Express Scripts will be notified of the cancellation request and the item will be added to the April meeting agenda for trustee ratification.



# National Preferred Formulary Update

Effective July 1, 2023, the Express Scripts National Preferred Formulary will be updated. ES will exclude 9 additional products. The list of new exclusions and preferred alternatives is available here.

ES completed an analysis through March 1, 2023 to determine member impact. Currently, there is one member across all of the CS Trust employers that will be impacted by this update. The impacted member will be notified.

## SafeGuardRx® Cardiovascular Care Value® Program Expansion

Effective May 1, 2023, Express Scripts will be expanding its SafeGuardRx® Cardiovascular Care Value® program by offering new benefits for members with heart failure. There will be expanded Therapeutic Resource Center (TRC) support for patients and new provider outreach for high-risk patients taking a select heart failure medication. Also, financial protection will be added through an early discontinuation reimbursement for participating preferred products.
