Preventive Coverage Services Update

On January 1, 2024, Pennsylvania (PA) Act 1 of 2023 was implemented as part of the preventive coverage services for both Capital Blue Cross and Geisinger Health Plan.

This act, established on May 1, 2023, was signed into law. The mandate requires insurance companies to provide coverage for one (1) supplemental breast screening (Magnetic Resonance Imaging [MRI] or Ultrasound [US]) every year for individuals at no cost share for those members at increased risk for breast cancer; including BRCA-related genetic counseling and genetic testing.

If a woman is believed to be at an increased risk of breast cancer due to:

- 1) Personal history of atypical breast histology.
- 2) Personal history or family history of breast cancer.
- 3) Genetic predisposition for breast cancer.
- 4) Prior therapeutic thoracic radiation therapy.
- 5) Heterogeneously dense breast tissue based on breast composition with any one of the following risk factors:
 - · Lifetime risk of breast cancer of greater than 20%, according to risk assessment tools based on family history.
 - · Personal history of BRCA1 or BRCA2 gene mutations.
 - · First-degree relative with a BRCA1 or BRCA2 gene mutation but not having had genetic testing herself.
 - · Prior therapeutic thoracic radiation therapy between 10 and 30 years of age; or
 - · Personal history of Li-Fraumeni syndrome, Cowden syndrome, or Bannayan-Riley-Ruvalcaba syndrome, or a first-degree relative with one of these syndromes.
- 6) Extremely dense breast tissue based on breast composition.

Coverage for BRCA-related Genetic Counseling and Genetic Testing is also included.

Per the National Comprehensive Cancer Network (NCCN) and American Cancer Society (ACS) if MRI/US is used, it should be in addition to, not instead of, a screening mammogram.
